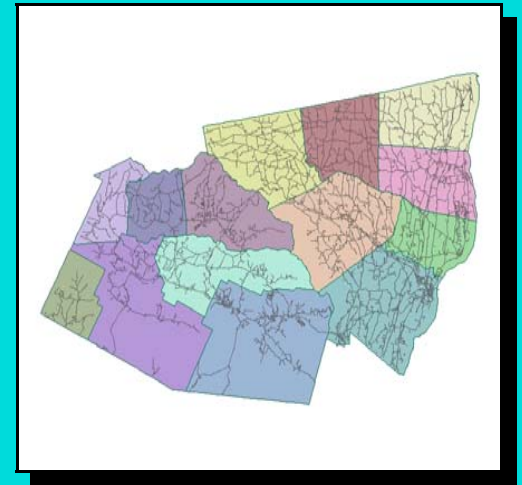

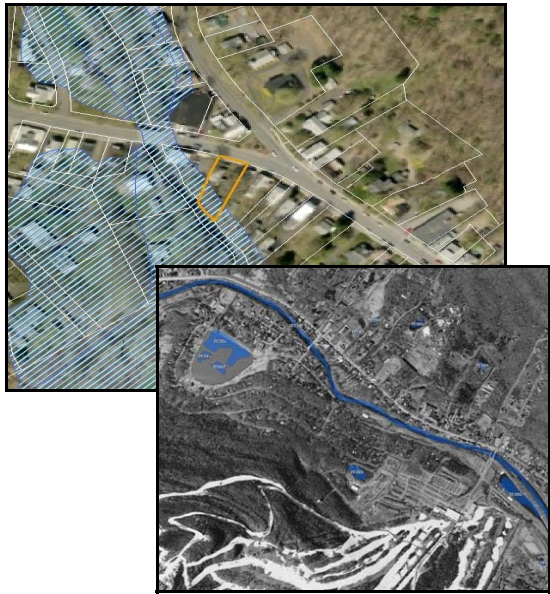

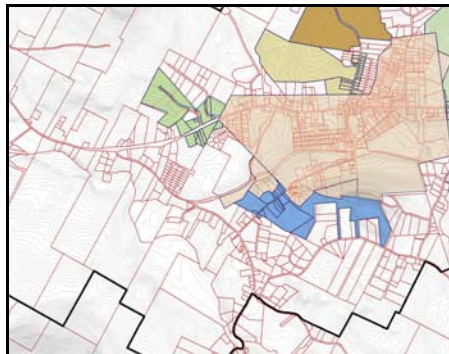
## Who Can Benefit from these Services?

## What Is GIS?

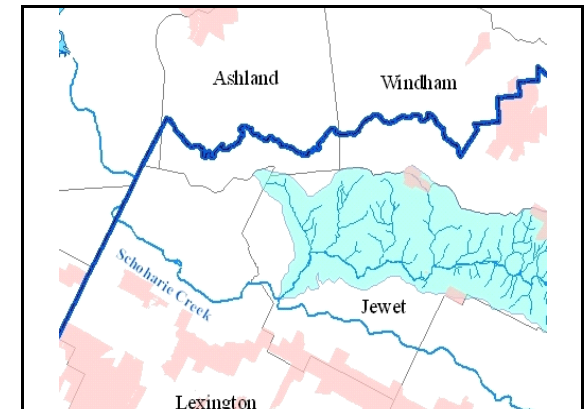
A geographic information system (GIS) integrates hardware, software, and data for capturing, managing, analyzing and displaying geographically referenced information. This collection of data can be used for thematic mapping in which the users can display several different layers of data for any given geographic area to create a custom map. For example, wetland maps can be superimposed upon parcel boundaries to display regulated areas.
