

Norway Spruce

Botanical Name: Pinus strobus

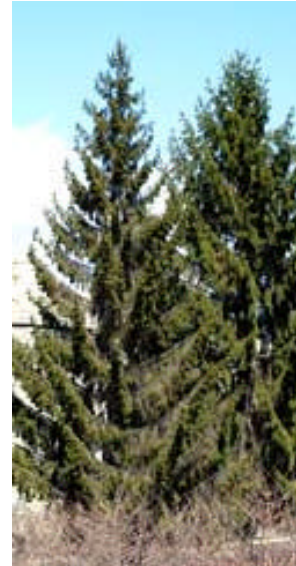
Foliage: Evergreen needles

Height: 40 to 60 feet

Spread: 25 to 30 feet

Shape: Upright

Light: Partial shade to full sun



Care: Prune in early spring, if needed. If being used as a hedge, prune the new growth. Water young trees thoroughly once a week in hot, dry weather. When watering, place hose at base of plant and let water trickle into soil.

Unique Characteristics: Norway Spruce is one of the fastest growing of all the spruces. As the tree grows older, the side branches become horizontal, turning upward at the tip. Secondary branches hang downward from the main branches, giving the tree a graceful appearance.
